□ WAUPS Fellowship

Who can apply

All WAUPS members who perform oral, maxillofacial, implant surgery, and other implant-related procedures using piezo devices.

Fellowship Processing Fee

Dentist: USD 300

The process fee will be charged after passing an evaluation by WAUPS Credential Committee, so please write your credit card details on an application form.

Requirements

- 1. You need to be an active WAUPS member for at least one year.
- 2. You need to attend at least once at WAUPS World Congress.
- Please submit fifteen(15) successfully completed implant cases including at least five(5) of those using piezo devices by filling in WAUPS's Clinical Case Forms.
 - The minimum requirement for clinical case documentation is the copies of pre-operative and post-operative x-rays and clinical pictures(each cases should list up more than 6 pictures).
- 4. You need to participate
 - At least one Oral presentation or Poster Presentation or Table Clinic
 - At least 1 case which was submitted through WAUPS Fellowship must be presented.
- 5. Submit a current Curriculum Vitae.

□ Poster Presentation

Submission Guideline

- Deadline for Abstract Submission: March 31, 2013
- Abstract must be sent to WCUPS 2013 secretariat by e-mail (wcups2013@pcored.com) and the file name must be the presenter's name.
 - · The Scientific Program Committee will consider the following categories
 - Bone Grafting
 - Sinus Grafting
 - Implant
 - Periodontic Surgery

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- Soft Tissue
- Other Surgical
- Abstract must be written in English, and include Objectives, Material and Methods, Results and Conclusions.
 The body must not exceed 400 words. The contents of an abstract must include the following components.

TiTle	The title should be concise.
Authors and Institution:	All responsible authors should be listed in full names. The degree and position of the authors are not required.
Objective(s):	State the main objective of the study or hypothesis tested.
Material and Method(s):	Briefly describe the design of the study and how it was conducted.
Result(s):	Present the main result(s). The statement of "The study results will be presented" is not acceptable.
Conclusion(s):	State only the conclusion(s) that is (are) directly supported by the results.

Poster Set up

- · 90 X 120cm board to display presenter's poster
- · Sign indicating the presenter's number
- · Poster set-up time is scheduled for April 20, 2012
- · Poster will stay on display until the conclusion of the meeting at 16:00 pm Sunday 21th April, 2013.
